	<p>Passage 2:</p> <p>If you want to send a message to a friend in another city, you can make a telephone call. If you have computer, you can send an e-mail. In the early 1800s, there were no computers, and Alexander Graham bell had not yet invented telephone. Most people wrote letters, but mail was slower than it is today. Mail traveled by boat or horseback, so a letter could take a very long time to go from one city to another.</p> <p>A man named Samuel Morse thought that people should have a faster way to send messages. Morse knew that some scientists had been working to solve this problem, and he began experimenting too. He had heard about machines that sent controlled bursts of electricity over wires. He built a better machine than the other scientists. His machine-the telegraph- sent short and long bursts of electricity over very long wires.</p>

Each combination stood for a letter of alphabet. for example, a short and a long burst stood for the letter A. One long and three short bursts stood for the letter B.
